

### TUITION AND OTHER EXPENSES

The total tuition for the Fast Track MBA program will be approximately \$74,300. Tuition is charged on a per-credit basis, and rates are set annually by Babson College's Board of Trustees. Discounts apply when 20 or more students enroll from one company for any given start date.

The cost of books and other course materials is separate and estimated at \$3,000 for the full program. Students also are responsible for their own travel arrangements and expenses.

### BILLING AND PAYMENT

Student account information and balances due are available online to enrolled students via the Babson Portal at <http://portal.babson.edu> under "Student Financial Services." Students are emailed upcoming payment deadlines; no hard-copy bills are sent. The following payment options are available:

#### EPAY

Students can make electronic payments at <http://portal.babson.edu> using MasterCard, Visa, Amex, and Discover credit cards, or from a checking or savings account.

#### BY MAIL

You can send checks and money orders to Student Financial Services (SFS). Checks must be drawn in U.S. dollars from a U.S. bank. Please make payable to Babson College, and mail to Student Financial Services, P.O. Box 57310, Babson Park, MA 02457-0310.

#### WIRE TRANSFER

Wire transfers should be routed to Citizens Bank ABA#011500120. Please include your name, student ID number, and a brief description (e.g., "Tuition Payment"). Please have the funds credited to Babson College's account #113742-2553 and allow three business days for the funds to be received. The international SWIFT Code is CTZIUS33.

#### IN PERSON

We accept cash, checks, and money orders in person at SFS, 3rd floor Hollister. Credit card payments also are accepted in person or over the phone.

#### EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN FOR COMPANY-SPONSORED STUDENTS

If tuition reimbursement benefits are paid directly to you, you can defer two-thirds of the tuition payment until after the end of the semester under this plan. An enrollment fee of \$50 and the first one-third of the tuition must be submitted by the payment deadline each semester.

## COMPANY PURCHASE ORDER OR AUTHORIZATION

If your company will be paying Babson College directly, you should arrange to get a company purchase order or letter of credit and submit it to SFS. You must submit a new purchase order or authorization from your employer each semester.

## FEES AND LATE PAYMENT PENALTIES

While we recognize that many students receive assistance from third parties, ultimate responsibility for all financial obligations rests with the student. Failure to receive notification of a payment deadline does not eliminate payment obligations or prevent the assessment of late payment penalties.

A \$50 fee will be charged for a returned check or electronic payment. A \$200 late payment fee will be charged to any student who has not met the semester payment deadline. The graduate school also will hold academic transcripts and diplomas, prohibit registration for a subsequent semester, and prohibit participation in commencement exercises for any student who has an outstanding balance.

Unpaid accounts will be referred for collection action, with the cost of collection to be borne by the student. Students who wish to appeal a penalty must write to SFS within 10 days of notification.

## REFUNDS OF CREDIT BALANCES

Students who wish to have a credit balance refunded should submit a refund request online at “Student Financial Services/View of Bill” at <http://portal.babson.edu>. Starting at the end of the Drop/Add period, requests for credit balance refunds received by Tuesday at noon will be refunded by Thursday at 2 p.m.

## FINANCING OPTIONS

There are a number of loan options that can be used to finance any portion of your educational costs, including travel and living expenses. We recommend that all U.S. citizens and permanent residents apply for the Federal Direct Stafford Loan first before pursuing any other loan option.

- Federal Direct Stafford Loan Program—U.S. citizens and permanent residents may apply by submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). The school code for Babson College is 002121. You may qualify for three academic years of funding; a separate FAFSA must be submitted for each year.
- Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan—U.S. citizens and permanent residents apply by completing the Graduate PLUS application at [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov).
- Private education loan recommendations are available at [www.babson.edu/graduate/tuition-financial-aid/financial-aid/loan-programs](http://www.babson.edu/graduate/tuition-financial-aid/financial-aid/loan-programs). You are in no way limited to these loans or lenders; Babson will process a loan from any lender, and it is your right to apply for loans through the lender of your choice.

Babson’s Student Financial Services counselors can advise you about these financing options.
