ISOS is foreign travel assistance providing support to students and employees who travel abroad on Babson College business and College sponsored programs.

What does ISOS Offer?

- Travel:
 - Visa information
 - Entry/exit requirements
 - Language and money
 - Legal Information
 - Cultural tips, including tips for women and LGBTQ+ community
- Medical:
 - Common diseases
 - Recommended vaccinations
 - Information about traveling abroad with medications
 - Referrals to centers of medical excellence
 - Medical monitoring
 - o Relocation to more appropriate centers of medical excellence
 - Medically assisted evacuations if needed
 - Medical Emergency Record
- Security:
 - o Crime and terrorist environment
 - o Common natural disasters (earthquakes, hurricanes, etc.)
 - Email alerts
 - Alerts pushed through <u>ISOS Travel Assistance App</u>
 - Coordination of evacuations resulting from man-made and natural disasters
