The 45th BCERC will be held at Babson College, Babson Park, MA, USA. The conference will focus on cutting-edge empirical research in progress that will significantly advance the field of entrepreneurship.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

- A two-page, maximum 900-word abstract, to include; Principal Topic, Method, and Results, should be submitted online to bcerc.babson.edu no later than October 16, 2024. Abstracts will be double-blind reviewed.
- Authors will be notified via email in December 2024 on acceptance of abstract.
- A one-page, maximum 400-word summary is due in March 2025. A six-page abridged paper is due in April 2025.
- Papers will be evaluated by members of the Board of Reviewers and selected for publication. The top 40 submissions will have their six-page abridged papers published in the 2025 issue of Frontiers of Entrepreneurship Research BCERC Proceedings (FER). The papers not selected as the top 40 will have only the one-page summary in the 2025 issue of FER.

DOCTORAL CONSORTIUM

The Doctoral Consortium is scheduled for June 4 and June 7, 2024. Twentyfive doctoral students pursuing research and teaching careers will have an opportunity to participate in the program and attend the conference. Application deadline is December 4, 2024.
