





Downloading data from Bloomberg using the excel plug-in


- 1) Create an empty excel file and save the file in a location of your choice.
- 2) Log in to Bloomberg/Bloomberg anywhere.
- 3) Type the function FILE and click <Enter>



4) Bloomberg will take you to the file manager screen. Here you have to click upload file.



5) You will see the window below. Click on my computer and navigate to the location of the excel sheet that you created in the beginning



6) Now you will receive a mail with your uploaded document. Click on the messages button at the top to access the message with the uploaded file




- 7) You will see a file alert in your inbox. Open the alert and click on the attached file, this will take you to the file manager window. Click on the file that got uploaded in the file manager window. A excel sheet will open with the Bloomberg plugin enabled.
- 8) Now in order to pull data from Bloomberg you have to go to the Bloomberg tab and click on the spreadsheet builder.




9) In the spreadsheet builder you have to choose the historical data table option




10) Now in the search box type in the security or the index of your choice and click next. In the next search box type the field/fields that you need, for example: last price, day to day total return.







11) In the next page you can enter the date range
