240 U.S. dual citizens and **124** U.S. permanent residents make up **11%** of the undergraduate and **10%** of the graduate student populations.



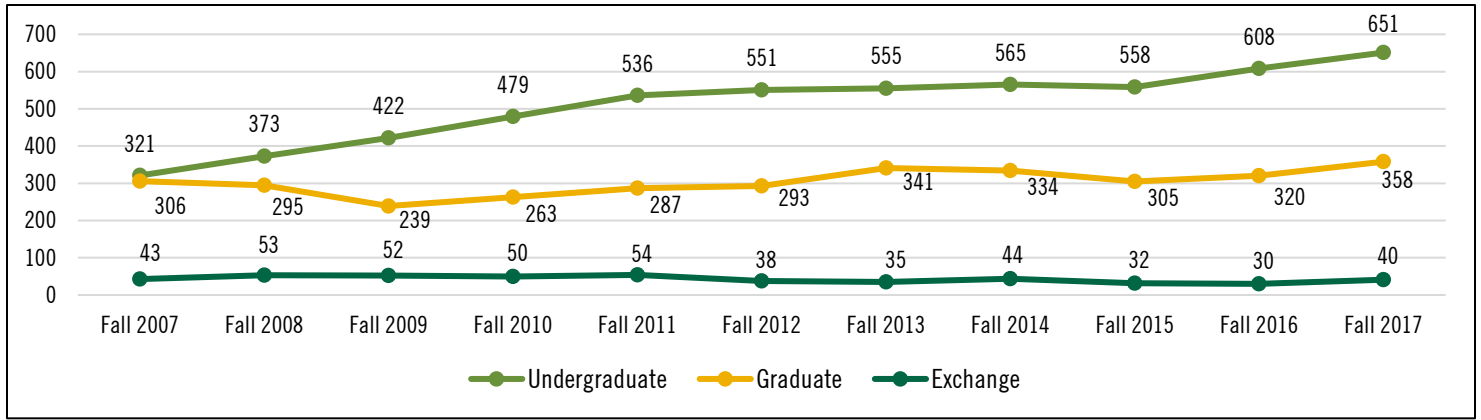
57% increase in the total international student enrollment over the past 10 years with a **103%** increase at the undergraduate level.

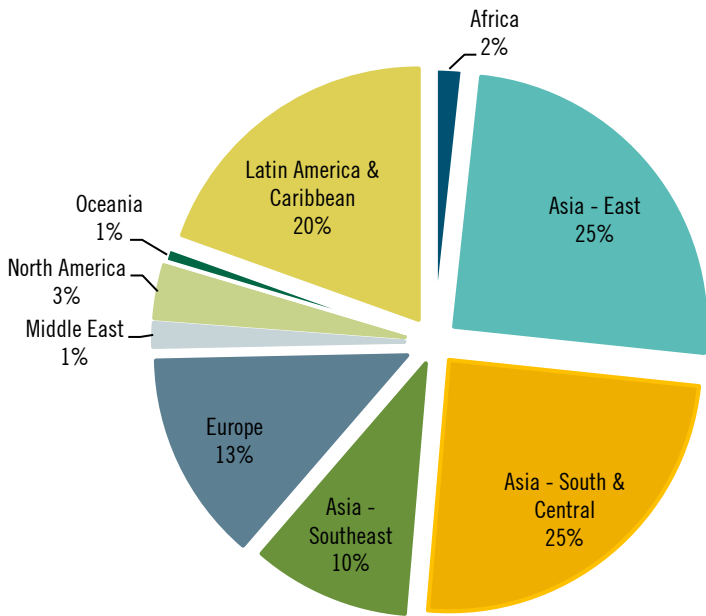
For the second year in a row, Babson was recognized as the top U.S. college for international students in terms of quality, student population, programs of interest, and more.

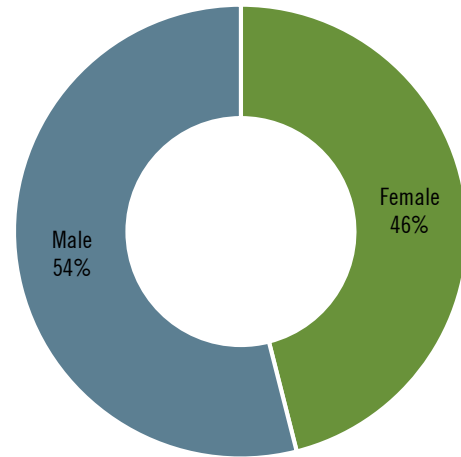
International Students at Babson College

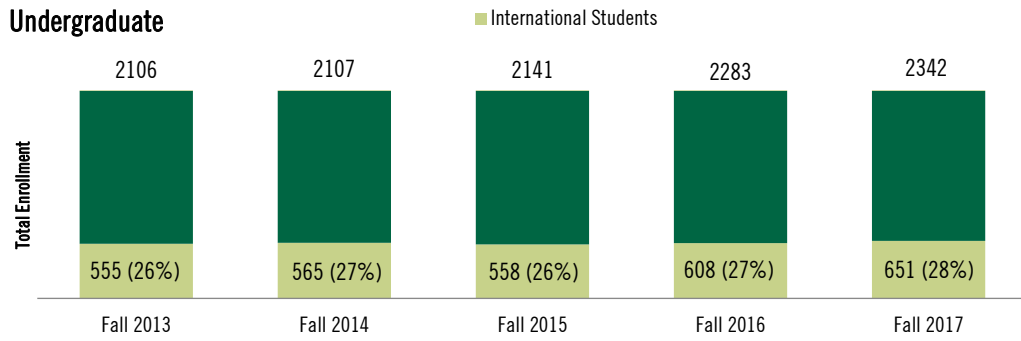

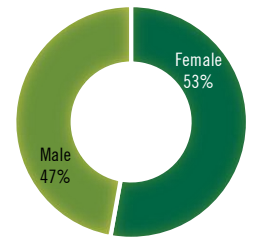

International Student Enrollment by Program & Gender

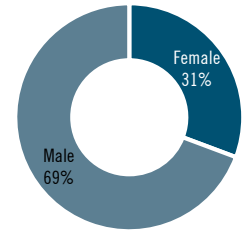
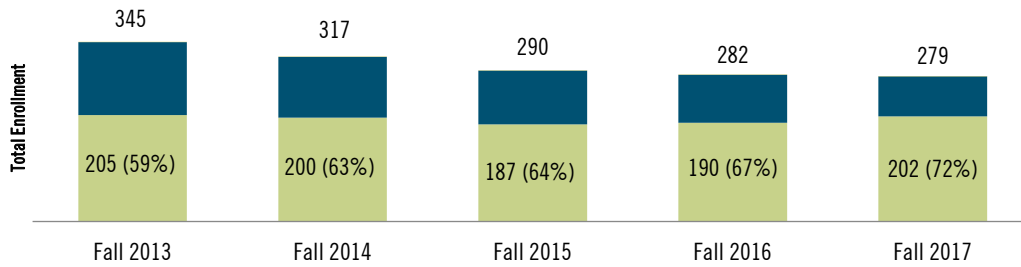

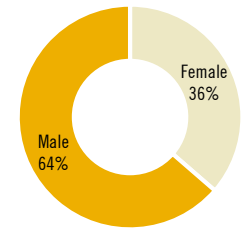
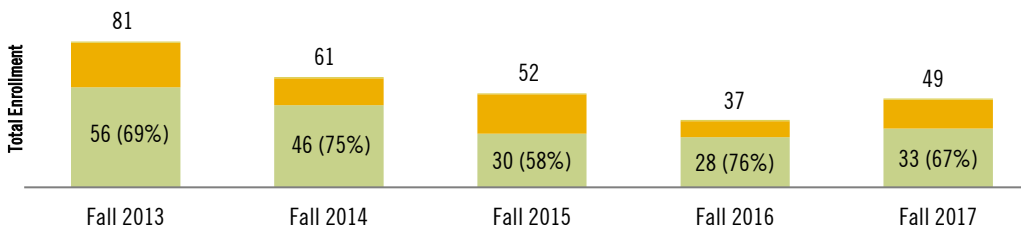
Fall 2017 by Gender



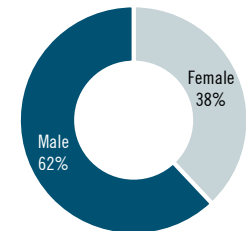
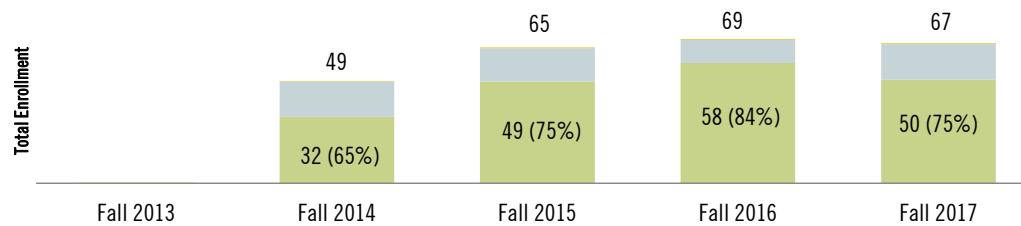
Two Year MBA



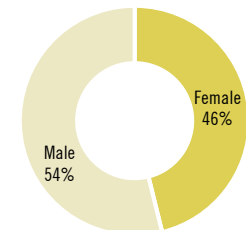
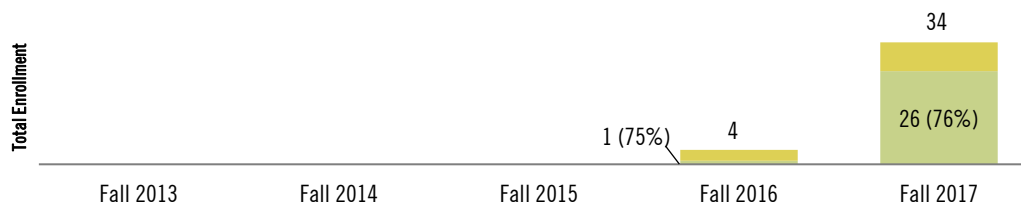
One Year MBA

MS in Finance (MSF)

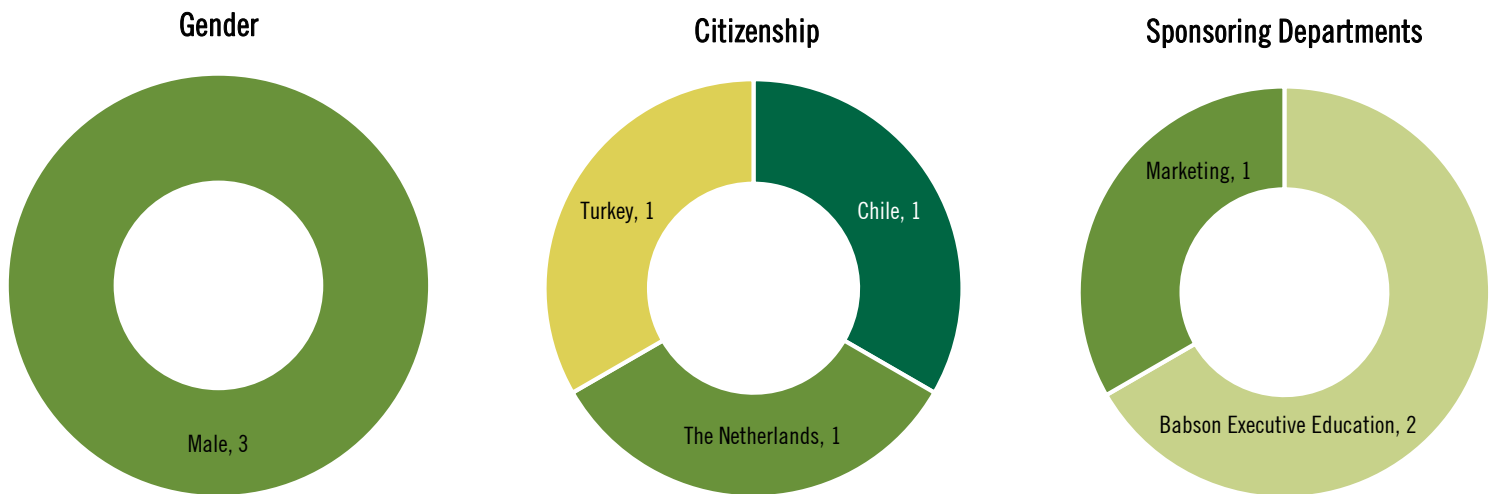
