| The Yellow Ribbon Program is subject to a maximum annual contribution and a maximum number of students – both of which are subject to change each academic year – determined by the college. For the current academic year, Babson will accept a maximum of twenty (20) students into the Yellow Ribbon Program and contribute a maximum of \$10,000 per student for the academic year. A Babson Yellow Ribbon award for the fall semester may be capped at \$5,000.00. | | | | |
