Dear Tenants:

Please be aware the Rockhill Property Management Office was notified earlier today that an individual who is employed by a tenant in 100 High Street has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. We understand that this individual was last in the building on February 8, 2021. We further understand that the local health authorities have been informed, and the individual has been asked to self-isolate and has not been on-site since that time. In addition, it is our understanding that the affected individual was wearing a face covering when last in the common areas of the building.

As we have indicated in prior communications, the building's high traffic common areas have been cleaned regularly using products with EPA-approved viral pathogen claims, and with an emphasis on high touch points including door handles, elevator call buttons and restroom fixtures.

Based on widely reported data regarding the prevalence and transmission of COVID-19 in most major metropolitan areas of the U.S., we expect to learn of many new confirmed cases within our community in the coming days and weeks. Please know that we will continue to track the timing and suspected path of travel of any new cases and will conduct our enhanced cleaning protocol as previously described.
