THE FIRST OF MANY

- ANTHONY RODRIGUEZ '24 BECAME THE FIRST MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY RUNNER TO QUALIFY FOR THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP BACK IN NOVEMBER
- WOMEN'S BASKETBALL, MEN'S BASKETBALL AND MEN'S ICE HOCKEY ALL MADE THE NCAA TOURNAMENT IN THE SAME SEASON FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY
- MEN'S ICE HOCKEY CLAIMED ITS FIRST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP ON HOME ICE WITH A 5-3 WIN OVER SKIDMORE
- OLIVIA SOFFER '25 EARNED WOMEN'S TENNIS' FIRST ALL-AMERICA HONOR AFTER BECOMING THE FIRST FEMALE IN PROGRAM HISTORY TO QUALIFY FOR THE NCAA SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP, WHERE SHE ADVANCED TO THE QUARTERFINALS
- KATHERINE JACOBS '22 EARNED THE FIRST ALL-AMERICA AWARD FOR THE WOMEN'S TRACK & FIELD PROGRAM IN THE 100-METER HURDLES

A RECORD BREAKING YEAR

- A DEPARTMENT RECORD 14 PROGRAMS WERE REPRESENTED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS
- WOMEN'S SOCCER SET A SCHOOL RECORD WITH 758 SCORELESS MINUTES AND SEVEN CONSECUTIVE SHUTOUTS TO END THE SEASON
- FIELD HOCKEY TIED ITS PROGRAM RECORD WITH 21 WINS, INCLUDING A SCHOOL-RECORD 17-GAME WINNING STREAK ON THE WAY TO REACHING THE NCAA QUARTERFINALS
- WOMEN'S ALPINE SKIING RECORDED THE BEST FINISH IN PROGRAM HISTORY (3RD) AND THE MEN'S TEAM MATCHED ITS BEST FINISH (TIED FOR 3RD) AT THE USCSA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS
- EACH OF THE SEVEN TEAMS TO QUALIFY FOR THE NCAA TOURNAMENT (FIELD HOCKEY, MEN'S SOCCER, WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL, MEN'S BASKETBALL, WOMEN'S BASKETBALL, MEN'S ICE HOCKEY AND SOFTBALL) ALL WON AT LEAST ONE TOURNAMENT GAME
- MEN'S GOLF EARNED ITS HIGHEST RANKING IN SCHOOL HISTORY (4TH) DURING THE REGULAR SEASON AND POSTED ITS HIGHEST FINISH IN DIVISION III HISTORY (TIED FOR 12TH) AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP
- MEN'S GOLF COLLECTED A RECORD FOUR ALL-AMERICA AWARDS, INCLUDING NICHOLAS GIANELOS '22 BECOMING THE FIRST IN PROGRAM HISTORY TO EARN ALL-AMERICA FIRST-TEAM HONORS
- MEN'S TENNIS EARNED ITS HIGHEST RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY (25TH) IN LATE MARCH
